We would also like to take this opportunity to remind you of our Ethics Code of Conduct for Service Providers, which all Teledyne third party sales and supply channels and other service providers are expected to follow. As a reminder, one requirement within the Code is that no Teledyne service provider shall engage in or facilitate forced labor, child labor, slavery or human trafficking. We also expect our suppliers to provide a workplace free from harassment and discrimination, as well as a safe and sanitary workplace.

Importantly, please be aware that Teledyne service providers are occasionally targeted by cyber-criminals seeking to misappropriate payments by pretending to be Teledyne employees and requesting the diversion of funds, or product shipments, to illegitimate destinations. We expect our service providers to have adequate cybersecurity and accounting controls to ensure their employees recognize questionable emails, and to prevent payments being made without proper review and authorization. Please ensure your sales and accounting personnel are made aware of these risks.
